HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE  
No. 9 OF 1943.

REGULATIONS IN CONNECTION WITH  
MANUFACTURE AND SALE OF CERTAIN  
MEALIE PRODUCTS.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the regulations set forth in the Annexure hereto relating to the manufacture and sale of certain mealie products in Basutoland, the Bechuanaland Protectorate and Swaziland.

ANNEXURE.  
REGULATIONS.

1. The regulations contained in the Annexure to High Commissioner's Notice No. 181 of 1942 are hereby amended by the substitution in the definitions of "fine granulated mixed mealie meal", "mixed mealie rice", "mixed samp" and "unsifted mixed mealie meal" in regulation 3 for the expression "not less than 10 per cent. and not more than 25 per cent.", wherever that expression occurs in the said definitions, of the expression "not less than 25 per cent., and not more than 40 per cent."

2. Nothing contained in regulation 1 of these regulations shall be deemed to prohibit any person (other than a person who grinds, crushes, grists or otherwise processes mealies from selling fine granulated mixed mealie meal, mixed mealie rice, mixed samp or unsifted mixed mealie meal which is in his

possession or under his control at the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette* and which he would have been entitled to sell if that regulation had not been made.

3. Any person who is, in pursuance of a contract entered into subsequent to the thirty-first day of July, 1942; but prior to the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette*, under an obligation to deliver fine granulated mixed mealie meal, mixed mealie rice, mixed samp or unsifted mixed mealie meal to any other person shall be deemed to have fulfilled that obligation if he has delivered to that other person fine granulated mixed mealie meal, mixed mealie rice, mixed samp or unsifted mixed mealie meal which complies with the requirements specified in the said definitions as amended by the said regulation 1 of these regulations.
