

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 94 of 1943.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers in him vested by sub-section (4) of section *three* and section *four* of Act No. 10 of 1911 (The Post Office Administration and Shipping Combinations Discouragement Act, 1911) of the Union of South Africa, as of force in the Bechuanaland Protectorate by virtue of Proclamation No. 28 of 1916 and of Proclamation No. 23 of 1928, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to approve, with effect from the 1st day of April, 1943, of the following addition to the telephone regulations of the Bechuanaland Protectorate published under Schedule B. of the aforesaid Proclamation No. 23 of 1928, provided that it shall be applicable also to rental prepaid beyond 1st April, 1943, and to unpaid call fee and phonogram debits incurred prior to 1st April, 1943, and included in the telephone accounts rendered on and after that date:—

All rentals and call fees payable by telephone subscribers in terms of these regulations, as well as the charges for phonograms despatched from subscribers' telephones, shall be subject to a surcharge of 12½ per cent., provided that fractions of less than one halfpenny shall be disregarded and fractions amounting to one halfpenny or more shall be increased to the next higher penny.
