PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER
Entitled the Railway Amendment Continuation
Proclamation, 1943.

Whereas it is expedient to amend further the
Railway Proclamation, 1935 (No. 37 of 1935), of
the Bechuanaland Protectorate;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers
in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make
known as follows:—

1. This Proclamation may be cited for all ^{Short} purposes as the Railway Amendment Con- ^{title and} ^{commence-} ^{ment.} tinuation Proclamation, 1943, and shall not come into operation unless and until the High Commissioner has declared by Notice in the *Gazette* that it is His Majesty's pleasure not to disallow the same, and shall come into operation on such date as may be fixed by the High Commissioner by the same or any subsequent notice in the *Gazette*.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of sub- ^{Continua-} ^{tion of} ^{Proclama-} ^{tion No. 61} ^{of 1941.} section (1) of section *nine* of the Railway Further Amendment Proclamation, 1941 (No. 61 of 1941), the said Proclamation shall not expire on the thirtieth day of September, 1943, but shall continue until the thirtieth day of September, 1944.
