9. Special meetings of the Committee can be called at any time by the chairman or by the written requisition of any two members of the Committee. Furthermore, a majority of parents or guardians having children at school may, by means of a joint petition to the chairman, call for a special Committee meeting, and such meeting shall be held within three weeks of the receipt of such petition.

10. Any member of the Committee who shall absent himself (with or without cause) from two consecutive regular Committee meetings (referred to in regulation 5) without leave of absence from the chairman, shall automatically cease to be a member of the Committee, and another member of Committee shall thereupon be appointed by the Committee.

11. All communications shall be through the Secretary.

12. The duties of the Committee shall be as follows:—

(a) To bring to the notice of the Director of Education any matter which concerns the welfare and efficiency of the school;

(b) to appoint teachers, subject to the approval of the Director of Education, and to dismiss or discharge teachers, subject to the approval of the Director of Education. Teachers dismissed or discharged shall have the right of appeal to the Resident Commissioner;

(c) to pay teachers and to enter into contracts with them as regards salary and terms and conditions of service; provided the contract shall first be approved by the Director of Education;

(d) to see that the Government grant is properly expended;

(e) to ensure that the Treasurer keeps full and suitable accounts of the income and expenditure of the Committee in respect of each twelve months ending the 31st December;

(f) to make available accounts for inspection and audit by any officer of the Government nominated by the Resident Commissioner;

(g) to ensure that in March each year a proper balance sheet, showing the financial position and signed by the Chairman and Treasurer, shall be submitted to the Director of Education by the Secretary, and a copy thereof shall be sent on the same day to the District Commissioner for his information;

(h) to ensure that for every amount paid out for books, labour, etc., a valid receipt shall be obtained and for every amount received a valid receipt shall be given;

(i) to decide the scales of fees to be paid. The Committee shall, at their discretion, have power to exclude from schools any pupil whose fees are two months in arrear. They shall also have power to sue for fees not paid;

(j) to ensure that the school is properly equipped and that the school buildings are kept in repair and the premises in a satisfactory condition;

(k) to control the uses to which the school premises may be put for purposes other than educational, subject, however, to any other conditions which may be applicable to any particular premises used for educational purposes;

(l) to secure suitable board and lodging for teachers on first appointment, the payment for same being the responsibility of the teachers concerned;

(m) to ensure that religious instruction is taught in every school, due regard being had to the religious views of the parents concerned;

(n) to see that pupils are properly equipped with books, etc., and that copies of the calendar and syllabus are kept at the school;

(o) to elect, if considered necessary, from its members an Executive Committee consisting of the Secretary and two other members to deal with matters of urgency. Action taken by such Executive Committee shall be reported in writing to the chairman within seven days and shall be subject to confirmation by the Committee.

13. Any member of the Committee shall, by arrangement with the chairman, have the right to enter the school in respect of which such Committee is constituted: Provided he does not interfere with the work that is being carried on therein.

14. Teachers are responsible to the Director of Education and to him alone for everything connected with the carrying out of their professional duties. Committees shall not interfere in professional matters which shall be understood to mean those concerned with the teaching of subjects as prescribed by the approved syllabus and set out in a time-table prepared by the head teacher and approved by the Director of Education; also matters concerned with any circulars issued by the Director of Education relating to times of attendance at school, the control of children in the school playground, the preparation of schemes of work, the maintenance of records of work and the administration and recording of punishment.

15. Principals of schools shall receive notice of, and may, at the discretion of the Committee, be summoned to any meeting of a School Committee, but shall not vote thereat. A principal shall retire from the meeting if it is desired by the Committee that he should do so.

16. The Committee shall have the right to refuse admission to any child whom they do not think it is in the interests of the school to admit: Provided, however, the parents of any child so excluded shall have the right of appeal to the Resident Commissioner, through the Director of Education.

17. It shall not be within the power of the Committee to alter the school calendar, but any recommendations in that regard may be submitted to the Director of Education.

18. In the case of an outbreak of sickness amongst the pupils the Secretary shall notify the medical officer of the district, and the medical officer will decide whether or not, and for how long, the school shall be closed.

19. The Director of Education will be solely responsible for the syllabus used in the schools and for all examinations. He will also prescribe the text books to be used.

20. The Director of Education shall, when necessary, submit reports on European schools and their control to the European Advisory Council, and it shall be competent for members to make suggestions and recommendations as to whether existing School Committees should be continued or whether a change of control is required.

21. Any change of school management shall first be approved by the Resident Commissioner before any change is put into effect.

22. In the event of dissatisfaction with any decision of the Committee or of the Director of Education there shall be an appeal to the Resident Commissioner, whose decision shall be final.
