

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.  
HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE  
No. 120 OF 1944.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend the regulations relating to mealies and mealie products published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 157 of 1943, as amended by High Commissioner's Notice No. 244 of 1943, by inserting the following as regulation 4A:—

“ 4A. As from the first day of June, 1944, the Controller may require any person importing mealies or mealie products from the Union of South Africa to pay a sum of 1s. 6d. per bag of 200 lb. net weight, or such other sum as may hereafter be fixed as a subsidy by the Government of the Union of South Africa; and any such sum shall be paid over to the Government of the Union of South Africa ”.
