CONTROL OF MACHINE TOOLS.
SALES BY AUCTION.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following regulations relating to the control of machine tools in Basutoland, the Bechuanaland Protectorate and Swaziland.

REGULATIONS.

1. In these regulations—

“ machine tool ” means any of the machine tools, equipment, attachments or accessories specified in the Annexure to these regulations;

“ Controller ” means the Government Secretary.

2. (1) From and after the date of publication of this Notice in the *Gazette*—

(a) no person shall sell by auction or offer or advertise for sale by auction, any machine tool; and

(b) no person shall hand over to any other person any machine tool for sale by auction, or authorise such other person to offer or advertise any machine tool for sale by auction,

except upon the authority of and subject to the conditions set forth in a permit issued by the Controller.

(2) Every application for a permit in terms of sub-regulation (1) hereof shall be submitted in writing to the Controller, giving a full specification of the machine tools to be disposed of and a statement of the reasons for such disposal.

3. Any person who contravenes any prohibition hereby imposed or who knowingly furnishes any incorrect or incomplete information shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding two hundred pounds or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding one year, or to both such fine and imprisonment.

NOTE.—This Notice in no way affects the necessity for obtaining a permit for the disposal and acquisition of machine tools in accordance with the regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 116 of 1942.

ANNEXURE.

- (1) Lathes of all types.
- (2) Automatic bar or chucking lathes, single or multi-spindle.
- (3) Turret and capstan or ram type turret lathes.
- (4) Drilling machines.
- (5) Shaping machines.
- (6) Grinding, lapping and/or polishing machines.
- (7) Threading and/or screwing machines.
- (8) Horizontal or vertical boring machines.
- (9) Planing machines.
- (10) Milling machines.
- (11) Slotting machines.
- (12) Cutting-off machines, including sawing and profile cutting.
- (13) Engraving machines.
- (14) Die-sinking and die-casting machines.
- (15) Projection machines; thread, length and diameter measuring machines; hardness testing machines; slip gauges.
- (16) Power operated woodworking machines.
- (17) All fixtures and attachments used with any of the machines (1) to (16) inclusive.
- (18) Presses, forging machines, welding machines, all types drop stamps, brakes, plate and sheet working machines.
- (19) All 2, 3 or 4 jaw chucks, hand or air operated.
- (20) Self-opening die-heads and collapsing taps of all types.
