CONTROL OF AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS,  
MACHINERY AND REQUISITES.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to order that the provisions of paragraphs (a) and (c) of regulation 3 of the regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 144 of 1942 shall cease to apply to the following articles:—

- (a) Windmill heads.
- (b) Windmill towers.
- (c) Borehole turbines.
- (d) Power working heads.
- (e) Centrifugal pumps.
- (f) Power-operated reciprocating pumps.

High Commissioner's Notice No. 173 of 1944 is hereby cancelled.
