PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Police
Offences Act (Extension) Proclamation, 1944.

Whereas it is expedient to extend the operation of Part I of the Police Offences Act, No. 27 of 1882, of the Colony of the Cape of Good Hope within the Lobatsi District of the Bechuanaland Protectorate:

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *one* of Proclamation No. 42 of Amendment 1907 is hereby amended by deleting the words ^{of Section 1 of Procla-} "one mile" and substituting therefor the ^{mation No. 42 of 1907,} words "two and one-half miles".

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the ^{Short title.} Bechuanaland Protectorate Police Offences Act (Extension) Proclamation, 1944.
