PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Game
(Amendment) Proclamation, 1944.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Game Proclamation, 1940, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law":

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1940. 1. Section *thirteen* of the principal law is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following proviso:—

" Provided that within the area of the Tuli Block District as defined in the Schedule to Proclamation No. 13 of 1905, large game and small game may also be hunted under the provisions of this section during the aforesaid close season, but only for domestic purposes and subject to such limitations as may be approved by the Resident Commissioner and endorsed by the District Commissioner on the gun licence of the person concerned."

1940. 2. Sub-section (2) of section *fourteen* of the principal law is hereby amended by inserting the following paragraph immediately after paragraph (b):—

" (c) he may grant a permit, subject to such conditions as he may think fit, to hunt, kill or capture any species of large game or small game on any land where he is satisfied that such game is causing damage to property or losses in farming activities."

Short title. 3. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Game (Amendment) Proclamation, 1944.
