PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Entitled the Railway Amendment Continuation
Proclamation, 1944.

Whereas it is expedient further to extend the life of the Railway Further Amendment Proclamation, 1941:

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The Railway Further Amendment Continuation Proclamation, 1941, shall not, in terms of section *two* of the Railway Amendment Continuation Proclamation, 1943, expire on the thirtieth day of September, 1944, but shall continue until the thirtieth day of September, 1945.

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Railway Amendment Continuation Proclamation, 1944, and shall not come into operation until the High Commissioner has declared by Notice in the *Gazette* that it is His Majesty's pleasure not to disallow the same, and thereafter it shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of October, 1944.
