PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Administration (Amendment) Proclamation, 1944.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Proclamation of the 10th June, 1891, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law":

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *forty-three* of the principal law is hereby amended by deleting the words "of European birth or descent" and substituting therefor the words "other than a native".

Amendment of section 43 of Proclamation of 10th June, 1891.

2. The following new section, numbered *forty-eight*, is hereby inserted immediately after section *forty-seven* of the principal law:—

New section 48 of Proclamation of 10th June, 1891.

48. For the purposes of this Proclamation the expression 'native' means any aboriginal native belonging to any tribe of Africa and includes persons of mixed race living as members of any native community, tribe, village or location in the Territory."

3. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Administration (Amendment) Proclamation, 1944.
