

## BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

No. 33 of 1944.

(Promulgated 15th September, 1944.)

### PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the High Commissioner

Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate General Dealers' Licences (Amendment) Proclamation, 1944.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the General Dealers' Licences (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Amendment Proclamation, 1924, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law":

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *one* of the principal law, as amended by section *one* of Proclamation No. 37 of 1929, is hereby amended by deleting the words—

"including the business of a butcher or baker, where such is carried on in the same premises"

and substituting therefor the words—

"including the business of a baker, and, in areas within which the Bechuanaland Protectorate Sanitary Regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 116 of 1934, as amended, do not apply, the business of a butcher, where such business is carried on in the same premises".

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Short title and commencement. Bechuanaland Protectorate General Dealers' Licences (Amendment) Proclamation, 1944, and shall have force and take effect from the first day of January, 1945.
