

## BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

(Promulgated 29th November, 1944.)

### PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER  
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Property  
Sales Restriction (Further Amendment Proclama-  
tion, 1944).

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the  
Bechuanaland Protectorate Property Sales Restriction  
Proclamation, 1943, hereinafter referred to as "the  
principal law";

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers  
in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make  
known as follows:—

1. Section *twelve* of the principal law is hereby amended by inserting the following at the end of sub-section (3):—

In respect of every application for the approval of an agreement of sale there shall be payable a fee of—

- (a) £3, if the purchase price of the property is £2,500 or less;
- (b) £5, if the purchase price of the property is more than £2,500.

2. This Proclamation may be cited as Short title.  
Bechuanaland Protectorate Property Sales  
Restriction (Further Amendment) Proclama-  
tion, 1944.
