

## BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

No. 6 of 1944.

(Promulgated 25th February, 1944.)

### PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER  
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Property  
Sales Restriction (Amendment) Proclamation, 1944.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Property Sales Restriction Proclamation, 1943, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law";

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Sub-section (3) of section *fifteen* of the principal law is hereby amended by deleting the words—

"on the first day of September, 1939" and substituting therefor the words—

"on the date of the purchase thereof by the intending seller, or, in the case of land held under a hire-purchase agreement, on the first day of September, 1939".

2. Section *nineteen* of the principal law is hereby amended by inserting, immediately after the word "sale" in the second line thereof, the words—

"to which this Proclamation applies".

3. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Property Sales Restriction (Amendment) Proclamation, 1944.
