PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the High Commissioner
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs
Duties (Amendment) Proclamation, 1944.

Whereas it is expedient to amend certain Customs Duties in the Bechuanaland Protectorate:

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Part III of the Schedule to the Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs Duties Amendment Proclamation, 1921, as amended, is hereby amended—

(a) by the substitution for the figures “ 0. 15. 0. ”, “ 1. 0. 0. ” and “ 1. 5. 0. ”, opposite the first three items relating to “ Spirits ”, of the figures “ 1. 5. 0. ”, “ 1. 10. 0. ” and “ 1. 15. 0. ” respectively; and

(b) by the substitution for the figures “ 1. 16. 0. ” and “ 3. 3. 0. ”, opposite the items relating to “ Beer ”, of the figures “ 2. 14. 0. ” and “ 4. 19. 0. ” respectively.

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs Duties (Amendment) Proclamation, 1944, and shall be deemed to have had force and effect as from the 24th day of February, 1943.
