

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

GOVERNMENT NOTICE No. 15 OF 1945.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under High Commissioner's Notice No. 17 of 1932, His Honour the Resident Commissioner has been pleased to declare the following area to be a "Stock Free Zone":—

All that area bounded on the north by the border between the Caprivi Strip and the Bechuanaland Protectorate and on the south by the following line: From a point on longitude 22 degrees east, 4 miles south of the border of the Caprivi Strip, west to a point on the western bank of the Okovango River, due east of the Mohembo Police Camp; from this point on the western bank of the Okovango River in a south-westerly direction to a point 4 miles due north of Gani Wells, and from this point due west and parallel to the border of the Caprivi Strip until the line intersects with the south-west border on longitude 21 degrees.
