CUSTOMS.—TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF  
DUTY ON KAFFIR-CORN IN THE GRAIN.

It is hereby notified for general information that, in terms of section *fifty-eight* of the Basutoland Customs Proclamation, 1944 (No. 46 of 1944), section *fifty-eight* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs Proclamation, 1944 (No. 51 of 1944), and section *fifty-eight* of the Swaziland Customs Proclamation, 1944 (No. 49 of 1944), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to suspend until further notice the customs duty of 2s. per 100 lb. provided for in item 15 (b) (i) of the tariff in respect of kaffir-corn in the grain imported into Basutoland, the Bechuanaland Protectorate or Swaziland, as the case may be.
