MACHINERY AND REQUISITES.

CONTROL OF TRACTORS.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following regulation relating to the acquisition of tractors in Basutoland, the Bechuanaland Protectorate and Swaziland:—

Notwithstanding anything contained in High Commissioner's Notices Nos. 144 of 1942 and 186 of 1943, every farmer who applies for a permit to acquire a tractor, whether new or used, shall, in addition to the particulars called for in Form A.M. 2 annexed to the said notices, furnish the following information in writing:—

1. When did you acquire the farm(s) on which the tractor applied for is to be used?.....
2. Since when have you been farming?.....
3. Is your main source of income derived from farming?.....
