HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 125 OF 1945.

RELAXATION OF CONTROL OF AGRICUL-
TURAL IMPLEMENTS, MACHINERY AND
REQUISITES.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following regulations:—

1. Schedule A to High Commissioner's Notice No. 144 of 1942, is hereby amended by the deletion of Item 2 of Part I thereof, with effect from the date of publication of this notice in the *Gazette*.
2. High Commissioner's Notice No. 186 of 1943, is hereby withdrawn with effect from the date of publication of this notice in the *Gazette*.

EXPLANATORY NOTES.

(a) The effect of regulation 1 of this notice is that engines of a horse-power not exceeding 20 brake horse-power may now be manufactured or disposed of without a permit.

(b) The effect of regulation 2 is that used tractors may be acquired without a permit.
