ACQUISITION AND DISPOSAL OF MEALIES
AND MEALIE PRODUCTS.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend High Commissioner's Notice No. 157 of 1943, as amended by High Commissioner's Notice No. 244 of 1943, by the addition of the following sub-section to regulation 4 which shall be re-numbered 4 (a):—

“ 4. (b) As from the first day of May, 1945, the Controller may require any person importing mealies or mealie products from Southern Rhodesia to pay a cess of one shilling per bag of two hundred pounds net weight.”
