CONTROL OF BUILDING MATERIALS.

**AMENDMENTS TO SCHEDULES B AND E OF
HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 342 of
1942.**

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend the regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 342 of 1942 (as amended by High Commissioner's Notices Nos. 91 of 1943, 176 of 1943, 256 of 1943 and 7 of 1944), with effect from the first day of February, 1945, by deleting Schedules B and E and substituting therefor the following Schedules:—

NOTES.—(1) The new amended Schedules (set out above) come into effect on 1st February, 1945. For purposes of returns, prohibitions, etc., the previous Schedules (as amended from time to time), will apply until 31st January, 1945. The returns due for the period ended 31st January, 1945 (which are due by 10th February, 1945), shall be based on the previous Schedules.

(2) As from 1st February, 1945, no returns (except as stated above) will be required in respect of the items which have been omitted from the new amended Schedules, and all prohibitions on the sales of goods enumerated in such items will be removed.

(3) In respect of items appearing in the Schedules with " Nil " percentages of prohibition or percentages of prohibition of less than 100, returns will continue to be required as heretofore covering both " prohibited " and " unprohibited " stocks of such items as well as of all other items shown. " Unprohibited " goods enumerated in such items may be purchased without permit, provided the purchaser requires the goods for immediate use and satisfies the supplier to that effect.

(4) Attention is drawn to the provisions of regulation 5 (3) of High Commissioner's Notice No. 6 of 1944, in terms of which non-ferrous materials included in Schedules B and E to High Commissioner's Notice No. 342 of 1942 (as amended from time to time) are exempted from the provisions of the last-mentioned regulations.
