PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Income Tax
Proclamation, 1945.

Whereas it is expedient to fix the rates of income tax to be levied in the Bechuanaland Protectorate in respect of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1945:

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. In terms of sub-section (2) of section *five* ^{Rates of} and sub-section (3) of section *seventeen* ^{Income} of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Income Tax (Consolidation) Proclamation, 1940, the rates of income tax to be levied in respect of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1945, shall be as follows:—

Normal Tax.

- (a) The rates of normal tax shall be the rates specified in paragraphs (a) and (b) of section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Income Tax Proclamation, 1943 (No. 18 of 1943).

Super Tax.

- (b) The rates of super tax shall be the rates specified in paragraph (c) of section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Income Tax Proclamation, 1943 (No. 18 of 1943).

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the ^{Short title.} Bechuanaland Protectorate Income Tax Proclamation, 1945.
