PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER
Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Medical,
Dental and Pharmacy (Amendment) Proclamation,
1945.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Medical, Dental and Pharmacy Proclamation, 1934, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law":

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *two* of the principal law is hereby amended by inserting the words "oculist or optician," immediately after the word "chemist," wherever the latter word appears in the said section. Amendment of section 2 of Proclamation No. 62 of 1934.

2. Section *three* of the principal law is hereby amended— Amendment of section 3 of Proclamation No. 62 of 1934.

(a) by inserting the words "oculists or opticians," immediately after the word "chemists," in the fifth line of sub-section (1);

(b) by inserting, immediately after sub-section (2), the following new sub-section:—

"(3) No person shall be entered on the register as an oculist or optician unless he is in possession of such diplomas or certificates as may from time to time be prescribed by the Resident Commissioner."

3. Section *six* of the principal law, as amended by Proclamation No. 7 of 1937, is hereby further amended— Amendment of section 6 of Proclamation No. 62 of 1934.

(a) by inserting the words "oculist or optician," immediately after the word "chemist," in the fifth line of the section;

(b) by inserting the following words at the end of the section:—

"In the case of an oculist or optician the registration fee shall be ten shillings."

4. Section *twelve* of the principal law is hereby amended by inserting the words "oculist or optician," immediately after the word "chemist," in the second line of the section. Amendment of section 12 of Proclamation No. 62 of 1934.

5. Schedule A of the principal law is hereby amended by inserting the words "oculist or optician," immediately after the word "chemist,".

Short title. 6. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Medical, Dental and Pharmacy (Amendment) Proclamation, 1945.
