GOVERNMENT NOTICE No. 5 of 1946.

BUILDING CONTROL.

Under the powers vested in me by regulations 3 and 4 of the Annexure to High Commissioner's Notice No. 199 of 1942, I, WALTER GERARD BRIND, Building Controller, do hereby prohibit, regulate and order as follows:—

1. Sub-regulation (b) of regulation 7 appearing in Government Notice No. 6 of 1943, shall be deleted and the following regulation substituted therefor:—

7 (b) any building or additions to any building the cost of which will not exceed or is not likely to exceed £100, provided that this exemption shall not apply—

(i) where any building or addition to any building has been erected on the same site, erf, stand, or lot within the preceding 12 months;

(ii) to the erection of or addition to any fence, garden or boundary wall built in concrete or brickwork or the construction of any swimming bath or bathing pool.

2. All permits issued prior to the 1st January, 1945, on behalf of the Building Controller in terms of regulation 3 of the regulations appearing in Government Notice No. 29 of 1942, and in respect of which no construction work has commenced at the date of this notice are hereby cancelled.
