HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 124 OF 1946.

REBATES OF CUSTOMS DUTY.

It is hereby notified for general information that, in terms of sub-section (2) of section *seventy-two* of the Basutoland Customs Proclamation, 1944 (No. 46 of 1944), sub-section (2) of section *seventy-two* of the Bechuáanaland Protectorate Customs Proclamation, 1944 (No. 51 of 1944), and sub-section (2) of section *seventy-two* of the Swaziland Customs Proclamation, 1944 (No. 49 of 1944), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend High Commissioner's Notice No. 4 of 1945 by the cancellation of paragraph 2 of Part III of the Schedule to that Notice, relating to the importation of salt under rebate of customs duty for use in the manufacture of certain commodities; provided that the said amendment shall come into operation fourteen days after the date of publication of this Notice and that, notwithstanding the cancellation of the said paragraph 2, the obligations of importers and manufacturers in terms thereof and of the relative regulations shall remain in force and effect until discharged, as if High Commissioner's Notice No. 4 of 1945 had not been amended.
