HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 212 of 1946.

EXPORT OF MANURE FROM TRIBAL AREAS.

It is hereby notified for general information that, in terms of section *thirty-one* (1) (a) of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Native Administration Proclamation 1943 (No. 32 of 1943), His Excellency the High Commissioner has approved of a rule made by the Barolong Native Authority whereunder all natives subject to its authority are prohibited from selling kraal manure to any person for export without the written consent of the Native Authority; and all authorised sales shall be under proper contract and at a minimum price of 15s. per ton at place of collection.

2. It is further notified for general information that, under the powers in him vested by section *thirty-one* (1) (b) of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Native Administration Proclamation, 1943 (No. 32 of 1943), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make a rule that no person residing within the area of jurisdiction of the Barolong Native Authority aforesaid shall purchase or acquire kraal manure from a native unless the seller has the written permission of the Native Authority and any such sale of kraal manure shall be under proper contract and at a minimum price of 15s. per ton at place of collection.

3. Any person who contravenes the provisions of the rule referred to in paragraph 2 of this Notice shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding fifty pounds or to imprisonment with or without hard labour for a period not exceeding one year or to both such fine and imprisonment.
