

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

No. 265 of 1946.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under the provisions of section *four* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Game Proclamation, 1940 (No. 19 of 1940), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to define the areas mentioned hereunder within which Royal Game, Large Game and Small Game, as specified in the First, Second and Third Schedules to the said Proclamation, shall be protected for a period of one year from the 14th June, 1946.

Provided that it shall be lawful for the Resident Commissioner to authorise the District Commissioners at Ghanzi and Tsabong to issue permits to natives residing within the said areas in their respective districts to hunt therein and kill game in reasonable quantities for food.

AREAS.

(a) That portion of the Ghanzi District which lies to the west of the 21st meridian of east longitude and south of latitude $22^{\circ} 30'$.

(b) That portion of the Kgalagadi District not declared a Game Reserve.

High Commissioner's Notice No. 123 of 1946 is hereby cancelled.
