HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE  
No. 267 of 1946.

REBATES AND REFUNDS OF CUSTOMS  
DUTIES.

It is hereby notified for general information that, in terms of sub-section (2) of section *seventy-two* of the Basutoland Customs Proclamation, 1944 (No. 46 of 1944), sub-section (2) of section *seventy-two* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs Proclamation, 1944 (No. 51 of 1944), and sub-section (2) of section *seventy-two* of the Swaziland Customs Proclamation, 1944 (No. 49 of 1944), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend High Commissioner's Notice No. 4 of 1945 by making the following additions to Part III of the Schedule thereto:—

- (10) Dichloro-Diphenyl Trichlorethane (D.D.T. Concentrate) Manufacturing Industry—Benzol.
- (11) Weed Killers Manufacturing Industry—Acetic acid, carbolic acid, red phosphorus, ethylene glycol, in bulk.
- (12) Crayon Manufacturing Industry—Stearine (Stearic acid), in bulk.

NOTE.—The effect of this notice is to allow a rebate of the whole duty on the above-mentioned articles when imported or taken out of bond by a registered manufacturer for use in the specified industries.
