

BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

No. 279 of 1946.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers in him vested by sub-section (2) of section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Herbage Preservation Proclamation, 1919 (No. 20 of 1919), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to apply the provisions of the said Proclamation to—

(1) the following areas as defined in High Commissioner's Notice No. 119 of 1923, as amended by High Commissioner's Notice No. 70 of 1944:—

- (a) The Kgalagadi District;
- (b) the Gaberones Block;
- (c) the Ngwaketsi District;
- (d) the Kweneng District;
- (e) that portion of the Lobatsi District known as the Barolong farms including the farm Panyane;
- (f) the Chobe District;
- (g) the Kgatleng District;

(2) All Crown lands as defined in section *one* of the Order-in-Council of the 16th May, 1904, and in section *one* of the Order-in-Council of the 10th January, 1910;

(3) the Tati Native Reserve as defined in the first Schedule to Proclamation No. 2 of 1911.
