HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 33 OF 1946.

RELAXATION OF CONTROL OF RUBBER.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Basutoland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 35 of 1939), section *one* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 36 of 1939), and section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following regulation:—

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in Part III of the regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 192 of 1945, as amended by High Commissioner's Notice No. 199 of 1945, no permit shall be required for the acquisition, disposal or fitment to any vehicle of Tractor, Road Grader, Agricultural Implement and Giant Tyres of the following sizes:—

EXPLANATORY NOTE.—This regulation relaxes the provisions of the regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 192 of 1945, as amended, to the extent that tyres of the sizes enumerated above may now be disposed of or acquired or fitted to any vehicle without a permit.
