HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE No. 173 of
1946.

MEDICAL SERVICE REGULATIONS.

It is hereby notified for general information that His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend High Commissioner's Notice No. 54 of 1930 by deleting the words "European bona fide residents" and substituting the words "European and other bona fide residents."

The High Commissioner has been further pleased to amend the regulations published under the above-mentioned notice by the addition of a new sub-regulation as follows, to be numbered 7 (f) (6) (b), the existing sub-regulation 7 (f) (6) being renumbered 7 (f) (6) (a):—

7 (f) (6) (b). The following charges shall be made for X-ray examinations in Government Hospitals:—

(a) For each film: £1. 1s.

(b) For each subsequent film of the same series (with a maximum of £3. 3s.): 10s. 6d.

(c) For each dental film (with a maximum of £3. 3s. for any one series): 10s. 6d.

provided that—

(a) no charge should be made for the examination of Government officials and employees and their wives and children who are entitled to free medical attention;

(b) no charge should be made for Africans who are *bona fide* resident in the Territory unless the examination is necessary for the treatment of illness or injury in terms of Workmen's Compensation Proclamation, No. 28 of 1936."
