## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Gold Premium Taxation (Amendment) Proclamation, 1946.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Gold Premium Taxation (Amendment) Proclamation, 1940:

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *six* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Gold Premium Taxation (Amendment) Proclamation, 1940, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following additional sub-section:—

Amendment of section 6 of Proclamation No. 63 of 1940.

“(5) The relief afforded by this section shall not be applicable to any miner for whose mining property a particular basic price greater than the general basic price of gold has been fixed in terms of sub-section (1) of section *five* of the principal law, as amended by this Proclamation.”

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the <sup>Short title.</sup> Bechuanaland Protectorate Gold Premium Taxation (Amendment) Proclamation, 1946.
