

# BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE.

(Promulgated 8th February, 1946.)

## PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Nurses and Midwives (Amendment) Proclamation, 1946.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Nurses and Midwives Proclamation, 1945, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law":  
Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *one* of the principal law is hereby amended by deleting the definition of "Director of Medical Services".

Amendment of section 1 of Proclamation No. 15 of 1945.

2. Section *three* of the principal law is hereby amended by deleting the words "Director of Medical Services" wherever they appear and substituting therefor the word "chairman".

Amendment of section 3 of Proclamation No. 15 of 1945.

3. Sub-section (1) of section *six* of the principal law is hereby deleted and the following sub-section is substituted therefor:—

Amendment of section 6 of Proclamation No. 15 of 1945.

"(1) The chairman of the Council shall be such person as may from time to time be appointed by the High Commissioner by notice in the *Gazette*."

4. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Nurses and Midwives (Amendment) Proclamation, 1946.
