PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate New Motor Car Sales Tax Repeal Proclamation, 1946.

Whereas it is expedient to repeal the Bechuanaland Protectorate New Motor Car Sales Tax Proclamation, 1941 (Proclamation No. 42 of 1941);

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers, in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Proclamation No. 42 of 1941 is repealed with effect from the first day of April, 1946. Repeal of Proclamation No. 42 of 1941.

2. Notwithstanding such repeal any tax or amount leviable or payable under the provisions of the repealed Proclamation which has not been collected at the date of repeal, may be levied and collected in accordance with the said provisions.

3. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate New Motor Car Sales Tax Repeal Proclamation, 1946. Short title.
