

SWAZILAND.

HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 133 of 1947.

It is hereby notified for general information that under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend regulation 35A of the Swaziland Defence Regulations, 1939, as amended by High Commissioner's Notice No. 150 of 1941, as follows:—

1. Sub-regulation (1) of regulation 35A is hereby amended by inserting, immediately after paragraph (*f*), the following additional paragraphs:—

(*g*) require any seller of specified goods to keep such invoices or records, to display such notices, and to provide the purchaser with such documents as the Resident Commissioner shall see fit;

(*h*) provide that the onus of proof in any transaction involving specified goods shall rest upon the seller;

(*i*) provide that on the sale of any specified goods it shall be unlawful for the seller to require the purchaser or prospective purchaser to purchase some other goods as a condition of the sale of the goods so specified.

2. Sub-regulation (2) of regulation 35A is hereby amended by inserting, immediately after the words "under paragraph (*f*) of sub-regulation (1)," the words—

"or who fails to comply with any requirement or contravenes any provision under paragraph (*g*) or (*i*) of sub-regulation (1),".
