HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

CUSTOMS: TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF
DUTY ON DESICCATED FULL CREAM MILK.

It is hereby notified for general information that, in terms of section *fifty-eight* of the Basutoland Customs Proclamation, 1944 (No. 46 of 1944), section *fifty-eight* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs Proclamation, 1944 (No. 51 of 1944), and section *fifty-eight* of the Swaziland Customs Proclamation, 1944 (No. 49 of 1944), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to suspend for a period of twelve months from the 11th July, 1947, the duty of 4½d. per lb. provided for in item 32 (a) (ii) of the Customs Tariff in respect of desiccated full cream milk imported into Basutoland, the Bechuanaland Protectorate and Swaziland.
