HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 226 OF 1947.

REBATES AND REFUNDS OF CUSTOMS
DUTIES.

It is hereby notified for general information that, in terms of sub-section (2) of section *seventy-two* of the Basutoland Customs Proclamation, 1944 (No. 46 of 1944), sub-section (2) of section *seventy-two* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs Proclamation, 1944 (No. 51 of 1944), and sub-section (2) of section *seventy-two* of the Swaziland Customs Proclamation, 1944 (No. 49 of 1944), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to amend High Commissioner's Notice No. 4 of 1945, by the addition of the following words after the word "packages" appearing in paragraph (5) of Part III:—

" Refined sugar, other than candy, icing, loaf and cube sugar, in such quantities and at such times as may be permitted by the Minister "

NOTE.—The effect of this notice is to allow, subject to the above-mentioned conditions and to the relevant rebate regulations, a rebate of the whole duty (which includes the suspended duty) on refined sugar when imported or taken out of bond by a duly registered manufacturer for manufacturing purposes.
