HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 231 of 1947.

REGISTERED COMPANIES AND TARIFF OF
PREMIUMS UNDER MOTOR VEHICLE
INSURANCE PROCLAMATIONS.

In terms of sub-section (1) of section *two* of the Basutoland Motor Vehicle Insurance Proclamation, 1946 (No. 17 of 1946), the Bechuanaland Protectorate Motor Vehicle Insurance Proclamation, 1946 (No. 18 of 1946), and the Swaziland Motor Vehicle Insurance Proclamation, 1946 (No. 19 of 1946), notice is hereby given that—

(1) the Legal and General Assurance Society, Limited, The Seven Provinces Insurance Company, Limited, and The Trans-African Insurance Company, Limited, have notified the High Commissioner, in writing, that they are willing to undertake the insurance under the above-named Proclamations of all classes of motor vehicles in Basutoland, the Bechuanaland Protectorate and Swaziland and that their tariff of premiums is as set out in the Schedule to High Commissioner's Notice No. 32 of 1947;

(2) the Voortrekker Lede Assuransie Maatskappy, Beperk, having notified the High Commissioner, in writing, that they will no longer undertake the insurance of motor vehicles under the above-named Proclamation will accordingly no longer insure motor vehicles under the aforesaid Proclamations;

(3) the A.A. Mutual Insurance Association, Limited, have notified the High Commissioner, in writing, that they have altered the tariff of premiums as follows:—

To the tariff of premiums set out in the Schedule to High Commissioner's Notice No. 32 of 1947 must be added an amount of 1s. in respect of any person who is not already a shareholder of the A.A. Mutual Insurance Association, Limited, to become a shareholder of the said Association.
