

BASUTOLAND.
HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 3 of 1947.

It is hereby notified for general information that, in accordance with the recommendation of the Education Commission, the Resident Commissioner, with the approval of the High Commissioner, has constituted a District Advisory Committee on Education in each of the nine Administrative Districts of Basutoland consisting of the following:—

A. *Ex officio* members:

- (i) The District Commissioner who shall be Chairman.
- (ii) The Education Officer of the District who shall be Secretary.

B. *Other Members*:

- (iii) A member of the Medical Department, appointed by the Director of Medical Services.
- (iv) A member of the Agricultural Department, appointed by the Director of Agricultural and Livestock Services.
- (v) Two representatives, of whom at least one must be an African, from each of the following Missions:—

The English Church Mission, the Paris Evangelical Missionary Society, and the Roman Catholic Mission, such representative to be nominated by the appropriate mission authorities and approved by the Resident Commissioner.

(vi) One African resident in the District nominated by the Paramount Chief.

(vii) Three Africans, resident in the District, of whom at least one should preferably be a woman, nominated by the District Council, but not necessarily members of it, and approved by the Resident Commissioner.

(viii) One representative of the Basutoland National Teachers' Association, nominated by the Local Branch of the Association and approved by the Resident Commissioner.
