HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE
No. 36 of 1947.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *one* of the Swaziland Emergency Powers (Defence) Proclamation, 1939 (No. 37 of 1939), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased further to amend the regulations published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 200 of 1946 by—

- (a) cancelling clauses (a) and (b) under sub-regulation (1) of regulation 1,
- (b) cancelling sub-regulation (2) of regulation 1,
- (c) the insertion after the end of regulation 3 (b) of the words:—

“ Provided that the controller may, notwithstanding, and in lieu of, the quantities specified in such permit specially fix the maximum quantity of meal which may during a specified period be sold or supplied to a particular person.”
