CUSTOMS.—TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF  
DUTY ON CEMENT FOR BUILDING PURPOSES.

It is hereby notified for general information that, in terms of section *fifty-eight* of the Basutoland Customs Proclamation, 1944 (No. 46 of 1944), section *fifty-eight* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs Proclamation, 1944 (No. 51 of 1944), and section *fifty-eight* of the Swaziland Customs Proclamation, 1944 (No. 49 of 1944), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to suspend, until further notice, the duty of 2s. 6d. per 400 lb. provided for in item 162 (a) (i) of the Customs Tariff in respect of cement for building purposes imported into Basutoland, the Bechuanaland Protectorate and Swaziland as the case may be.
