HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE

CUSTOMS.—TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF
DUTY ON PAPER BAGS IMPORTED FOR THE
PACKING OF FERTILIZERS, GRAIN AND
SUGAR.

It is hereby notified for general information that, in terms of section *fifty-eight* of the Basutoland Customs Proclamation, 1944 (No. 46 of 1944), section *fifty-eight* of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Customs Proclamation, 1944 (No. 51 of 1944), and section *fifty-eight* of the Swaziland Customs Proclamation, 1944 (No. 49 of 1944), respectively, His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to suspend until further notice the customs duties of 30 per cent. *ad valorem* and 1½d. per lb. provided for in items 282 (a) and 282 (b), respectively, of the Customs Tariff in respect of printed and unprinted multi-walled paper bags, of five ply and over, imported into Basutoland, the Bechuanaland Protectorate or Swaziland, as the case may be, for the packing of fertilizers, grain and sugar.
