PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate
Ex-Serviceman's Protection (Amendment)
Proclamation, 1947.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Ex-Serviceman's Protection Proclamation No. 15 of 1946, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law":

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Paragraph (d) of the definition of "Benefit" contained in section *one* of the principal law is hereby deleted, and the following paragraph (d) substituted in lieu thereof:—

"(d) any other Government of any of the Dominions, Colonies or Protectorates within the British Commonwealth of Nations or any territory in respect of which a mandate on behalf of the League of Nations has been accepted by His Majesty."

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Ex-Serviceman's Protection (Amendment) Proclamation, 1947, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
