PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER

Entitled the Swaziland Appropriation Proclamation,
1947.

Whereas it is expedient to make provision out of the public revenue or other funds of Swaziland for the services of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1947.

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers, authorities and jurisdiction conferred upon and committed to me by His Majesty under the Swaziland Order in Council, 1903, as amended by the Swaziland Order in Council, 1906, and the Swaziland Order in Council, 1909, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The public revenue or other funds of Swaziland are hereby charged towards the services of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1947, with a sum of £310,496 (three hundred and ten thousand, four hundred and ninety-six pounds).
Public revenue charged with £310,496.

2. The moneys granted by this Proclamation shall be applied to the purposes and services set forth in the Schedule annexed hereto and more particularly specified in the Estimates of the Expenditure of Swaziland for the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1947, submitted to and approved by the Secretary of State for Dominion Affairs.
Purposes for which moneys to be applied.

3. The moneys granted by this Proclamation shall not be issued or applied to any use, intent or purpose other than the particular services to which the said amounts have been granted respectively by this Proclamation.
Moneys not to be used for other purposes.

Short title and commencement. 4. This Proclamation may be cited as the Swaziland Appropriation Proclamation, 1947, and shall be deemed to have had force and effect as from the first day of April, 1946.
