PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER
Entitled the Basutoland Poll Tax (Amendment)
Proclamation, 1947.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Basutoland Poll Tax Proclamation, 1933, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law":

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Sub-section (2) of section *two* of the principal law is hereby repealed and the following sub-section is substituted therefor:—

"(2) The Resident Commissioner may also exempt from the payment of the whole or any portion of poll tax or any arrears thereof any person who shall satisfy him that he is indigent or that for any other sufficient reason he is unable to pay the tax."

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Basutoland Poll Tax (Amendment) Proclamation, 1947.
