PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER
Entitled the Swaziland Aliens (Amendment)
Proclamation, 1947.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Aliens Proclamation (Swaziland), 1937 (No. 28 of 1937), hereinafter referred to as „ the principal law ”;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers, authorities and jurisdiction conferred upon and committed to me by His Majesty under the Swaziland Order in Council, 1903, as amended by the Swaziland Order in Council, 1906, and the Swaziland Order in Council, 1909, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

Regulation
of re-entry

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1) of section *twelve* of the principal law, no alien who possesses the nationality of a state with which His Majesty is at war, or was at war at any time since the third day of September, 1939, and who is absent from the Territory at the date of commencement of this Proclamation, shall re-enter the Territory except in accordance with the provisions of section *two* of the principal law as amended.

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Swaziland Aliens (Amendment) Proclamation, 1947.
