PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

Entitled the Railway (Amendment) Proclamation,
1947.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Railway Proclamation, 1935, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law":

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of sections *eleven* and *twenty* of the principal law, ^{Amendment of sections 11 and 20 of Proclamation No. 37 of 1935.} the Companies shall not be required to submit to the Commission accounts, returns and statements for the year ending on the thirtieth day of September, 1947.

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the ^{Short title.} Railway (Amendment) Proclamation, 1947.
