PROCLAMATION

By HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER
Entitled the Basutoland Trade Marks Registration
(Amendment) Proclamation, 1947.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Basutoland Trade Marks Registration Proclamation, 1921, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law":

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The Schedule to the principal law is hereby repealed and the following Schedule substituted therefor:—
