### PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

Entitled the Bechuanaland Protectorate Restaurant Keepers (Amendment) Proclamation, 1947.

Whereas it is expedient further to amend Proclamation No. 38 of 1934 which makes provision for the licensing of keepers of restaurants, refreshment rooms and tea rooms in the Bechuanaland Protectorate, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law":

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section *one* of the principal law, as amended by Proclamation No. 49 of 1940, is hereby further amended by inserting, immediately after the words "cakes or pastry", the words—

"or such tinned foods as may be specified by endorsement on the licence,".

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Restaurant Keepers (Amendment) Proclamation, 1947.
