PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

Entitled the Basutoland Trading (Amendment) Proclamation, 1947.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Basutoland Trading Proclamation, 1928, hereinafter referred to as "the principal law":

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. The Second Schedule to the principal law is hereby amended by deleting item (8) and substituting therefor the following item:—

- “ (8) (a) European baker ... £5. 0. 0. Amendment of Second Schedule to Proclamation No. 28 of 1928.
(b) Native baker in a Government Reserve or within two miles of any boundary thereof £2. 0. 0.
(c) Any other Native baker £1. 0. 0. ”

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the short title. Basutoland Trading (Amendment) Proclamation, 1947.
